



GLASS CLEANING & MAINTENANCE RECOMMENDATIONS

All glass products produced by Blue Star Glass, Inc. require routine cleaning to prevent excessive build-up of potentially harmful deposits and contaminants.

CONSTRUCTION CLEANING

During construction, the glass may become heavily soiled and special care should be taken during the initial cleaning. The first time the glass is cleaned after or during construction, the glass should first be rinsed with water. This will remove any potentially harmful debris that may scratch the glass during the cleaning process. Next, the glass should be cleaned with a soft, clean, lint and grit-free cloth and a mild, non-abrasive, non-alkaline cleanser (such as a mild dish soap solution). The glass should then be rinsed immediately with clean water and squeegee any excess water from the glass surface.

ROUTINE CLEANING

For routine cleaning, a conventional glass cleaner or mild dish soap solution may be used. Apply the cleaner uniformly to the glass surface with a soft, grit-free cloth, sponge or pad and rinse completely. Wipe the glass with a clean, dry, grit-free cloth or squeegee dry. Special care should be taken to ensure no metal particles are trapped between the cleaning cloth and glass as this may scratch the glass. Extreme care should be taken with the use of glazing tools such as razor blades and putty knives as metal tools may scratch or damage the glass.
